

LAKE TARLETON

(Piermont)

ACRES: 315

MAX. DEPTH: 66'

FISH SPECIES: Rainbow Trout, Brown Trout, Lake Trout, Smallmouth Bass, Pickerel, Horned Pout

ACCESS: A newer facility with a concrete ramp and good turn around. There is paved parking for 4 trailers and 4 cars.

GPS: N43 58.052 W71 57.801

DIRECTIONS: From the junction of Routes 25 and 25C in Warren, take Route 25C for 5.1 miles. The boat access is on the right at the southeast corner of the lake.

COMMENTS: Lake Tarleton, situated on the edge of White Mountain National Forest, has little shoreline development and is stocked with Rainbow and Brook Trout.
